On January 4, 2016 a Deputy attempted to conduct a traffic stop on a 2010 Ford Expedition whose license plate came back as showing the vehicle was stolen. The Expedition began to pick up speed when the Deputy activated his lights and siren. The Expedition began to reach speeds in excess of 110 miles per hour and was headed north on I-49. The vehicle exited on the AA ramp and gave up the pursuit when the driver observed another Deputy who had deployed spike strips. The driver, identified as Jeremy Walter Krogsdale (DOB 11/11/1987), was placed in handcuffs and was placed in the Deputy's patrol car. There was a passenger in the Expedition who was identified as Louanna Jean Bush (DOB 12/3/1976) was also placed into custody. The Deputy conducted a search of the Expedition and located drug paraphernalia that field tested positive for Methamphetamines. Both Krogsdale and Bush were transported to the Bates County Jail.

Bush has several warrants from other jurisdictions that includes a warrant from the City of Rich Hill for Failure to Appear. The bond is \$415.00 cash only. She also has 2 warrants from City of Independence for Driving While Suspended or Revoked. Each bond on those 2 warrants is \$2400.00 cash only. City of Independence had also issued a warrant for Bush for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia with a bond amount of \$2000.00 cash only. Bush also had a warrant out of Jackson County for Possession of a Controlled Substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana with a bond amount of \$4000.00 with 10% allowed. Bush received charges out of Bates County on the above incident for Possession of a Controlled Substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana. The bond for this charge was set at \$10000.00 cash or surety.

Krogsdale was charged in Bates County with Possession of a Controlled Substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana and also for resisting arrest. His bond was set at \$15000.00 cash or surety.

Both subjects are currently being held in the Bates County Jail and are currently able to bond on all of the above charges.
